### 2J FAMILY ASSEMBLY

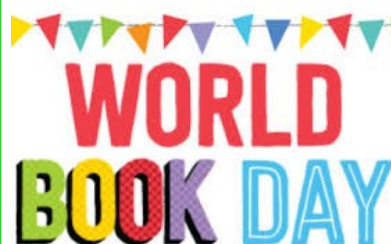
