

### **Mufti days**

Mufti days are days where all children wear their own clothes, NOT school uniform. These mufti days can sometimes be a reward to the children for bringing in any of the donations below.

### **Bottle donation days**

All children are asked to bring in a FULL bottle of anything they choose. This could be a bottle of squash/cordial, fizzy drink, alcohol or a bottle of bubble bath, shower gel, moisturiser etc.

### **Jam jar donation days**

All children are asked to bring in a jam jar FILLED UP with anything of their choice. The idea is to get an empty jam jar and then fill it with either sweets, pens/pencils, rubbers, stickers, craft items, mini toys, anything you like, as long as it will fit into the jam jar.

### **Chocolate donation days**

All children are asked to bring in bars or boxes of chocolates.

### **Hamper auction donation days (for the Christmas fayre)**

We run a silent auction on 4 hampers at the Christmas fayre. Each hamper has a different theme as follows:

Chocolate – Nursery & Reception

Craft – Year 1 & Year 2

Pamper yourself – Year 3 & Year 4

Cheese & Wine – Year 5 & Year 6

We ask that parents either donate something towards their year's hamper or give a cash donation to your class rep, who will then buy something on your behalf. (Please discuss with your class rep if you would prefer to give a cash donation as this will need to be done before the donation deadline.)

### **Cake & Pre-loved/2<sup>nd</sup> hand Uniform sales**

There are 8 cake and uniform sales each academic year. These sales take place on a set Friday (subject to change) at 3.10pm in the main playground (dates will be notified to the Class reps who will inform the parents in their year).

Each Year of children has responsibility for one cake sale a year. Parents/children are asked to bring in cakes (ideally which can be sold individually rather than large cakes which need to be cut up) or biscuits on the morning of the sale. Class reps will ask parents in that year to volunteer to help sell the cakes. The sale usually last 20mins.

Pre-loved/2<sup>nd</sup> hand uniform will be sold alongside the cakes where you can buy most school items 2<sup>nd</sup> hand at a fraction of the full cost. The PTA Uniform reps will be responsible for running these.

Parents will always be notified of all of the above occasions in advance, via the weekly school newsletter and also via a text reminder.
