## Introduction

## Objectives

1. **Reduce** – using and discarding fewer materials generally; using both sides of a sheet of paper where possible; switching off lights and equipment when not in use, and identifying and using cost-effective energy-efficient products where practical to do so.
2. **Re-use and repair** – re-using materials where appropriate and repairing/adapting or upcycling where possible.
3. **Recycle** – separating materials for recycling, such as paper, cardboard, cans, plastic bottles, printer consumables, rainwater, and kitchen waste.
4. **Responsibly dispose** – comply with the Environmental Protection Act 1990.
