SCHOOL DINNERS

4SG SWIMMING

Year 4SG will start swimming at Hurst Pool on Monday 16th September. Would you please take your child to the pool at **8.45am** and wait with them until they have been registered with the teacher. Children should bring trunks/one piece costume, towel and swimming cap in a waterproof bag. Please note that only designated helpers may remain at the pool during the lesson.

If your child is in breakfast club, would you please ensure that they are at the school by 8.10am in order to walk down to the pool with the class teacher. Please note that there will not be enough time to have breakfast before they leave for the pool. Year 4SG will have 6 swimming lessons this half term, the last one being on 21st October. Their PE kits will only be needed in school from Tuesday to Friday during this period.

PENALTY NOTICE

We would like to remind parents that, if you take your child out of school without the school's permission for 5 or more days, you will be liable to receive a penalty notice. Currently, the amount payable under a penalty notice is £60 if paid within 21 days, rising to £120 if paid between 21 and 28 days. If the penalty notice remains unpaid after 28 days, the Local Authority will consider a prosecution in the Magistrates' Court. Please note that penalty notices are issued per parent/carer per child, so if there are 2 parents and 2 children they will receive 4 penalty notices.
