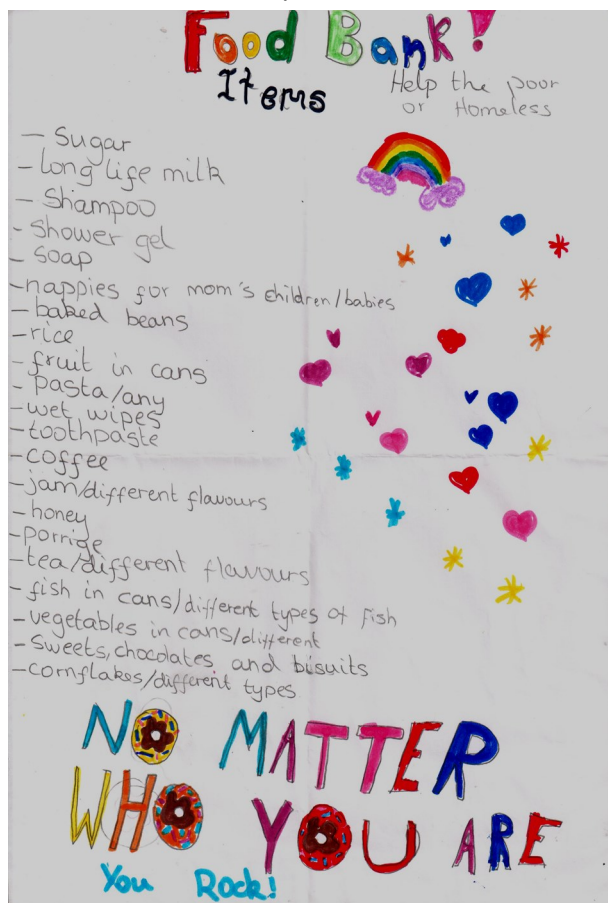

NEW MUSICIANS INSTITUTE

On Thursday, Hurst Park had an assembly with New Musicians Institute who run two music programs at our school. Jamming Together is a pop/rock, band-based program open to Year 3 students upwards, wishing to play and regularly perform in a band. No experience is necessary and all singers and instrumentalists are welcome. Drums, keyboards and electric guitars can be provided. The 30 minute class runs during school time on Thursdays with a professional musician. Sessions are priced at half the cost of private music lessons - £7.50 per 30 minute session.

JamTrax is a music technology after school club. Children compose soundtracks and work with sound effects for audio visual projects using iPads and Apple music software. These workshops run after school on Fridays - £7.50 per 40 minute session.
